FIERS À CHEVAL ENCHANTS AUDIENCE

Visitors to Jumping Indoor Maastricht can enjoy a unique show during this edition: Fiers à Cheval by Compagnie des Quidams from France.

Founded in 1994 by artistic director Jean-Baptiste Duperray, the company gives 150 to 200 performances a year and has since performed in some 50 countries, from Costa Rica to South Africa, via Japan and Australia.

With a visual, luminous and musical show, the company will take over the arena with the help of beautiful illuminated costumes and enchant the audience. The show will be seen on Friday evening and Saturday afternoon and evening.



LAURA KRAUT WANTS TO KEEP WINNING VIBE

Laura Kraut, the 'grand lady' of American show jumping is back at the MECC after years. "I'm really looking forward to it, it's been years since I started in Maastricht. I don't even remember when that was, but I think 2006 or 2007. It's more or less a home race for me, we're only an hour away from Maastricht." The 56-year-old, who travels a lot back and forth between the USA, the UK and spends the summer in Limburg is taking her best horse with her. "I am taking my Olympic horse Baloutinue to JIM, which I

will start in the Grand Prix. I am also bringing a very nice new horse, nine-year-old Dorado and eight-year-old Bisquetta. These three I will start in Maastricht and in Genève, so two big competitions in a row." In Washington Kraut won a competition and stayed clear in the Grand Prix, how does she see her chances in the MECC, "I definitely want to keep that 'winning vibe' here. If Baloutinue feels good I definitely have a chance. I haven't started the other two indoors yet, so that will be a wait and see."

KOOS DE RONDE GOES FOR TOP THREE RANKING

Koos de Ronde won the first edition of the FEI Driving World Cup qualifier at JIM in 2018. He is hugely looking forward to this year's competition. "The first World cup competition in Lyon is over. It always takes some getting used to after a busy summer, but in mid-October we had our indoor at home and that was a fantastic warm-up with 15 four-in-hands and a cool atmosphere. In Lyon, I had two new horses in my team who I bought this summer, so that took extra getting used to. The first day I had a few small mistakes, but on Sunday it went fine and clear. With Lyon in mind, I will take the same horses in Maastricht, because gaining experience is only possible at events like this. The audience is great and the track fine and compact. I'm really looking forward to JIM. Maastricht is the only World Cup competition in my own country, it is so cool to ride in front of 'your own' audience. There are supporters coming along and that makes it extra special." How does he rate his chances? "The difference between winning and losing is much smaller at these competitions than in the outdoor season, but I'm going for a top-three ranking, and who knows ..."





FRIDAY AFTER PARTY WITH XANDER DE BUISONJÉ

On Friday and Saturday evening, there will be a smashing party for the public in the 'village'. Both nights, DJ Rico Vrijhoeven will provide a great atmosphere from 21.00 hrs.

Two top artists will perform during JIM. On Friday evening, 11 p.m., the well-known singer Xander de Buisonjé, also known as host of Vrienden van Amstel Live!, will perform in the village. Saturday evening, same time, visitors can enjoy the popular Trijntje Oosterhuis.


So not only top-class sport at Jumping Indoor Maastricht, but there is also much to enjoy and experience culturally in the MECC.


